How do I fulfill my first-year Learning Community requirement?

You can fulfill your first-year Learning Community requirement in one of three ways:

- 1) Year-One experience
- 2) CHARGE Program
 - a. Contacted by Kristal Studer
- 3) Honors Eccles Scholars program
 - a. Contacted by Madison Abele

Most incoming honors students will fulfill their first-year Learning Community requirement through the Year-One experience, or sometimes referred to as “YO!”. Year-One is a cohort-based experience that pairs 25 students from different majors and backgrounds with two peer mentors. Under the direction of your peer mentors, you will meet weekly to explore topics decided by your cohort and those we view as essential to your success in the Honors College (e.g., Academic Success, Community, Resources and Exploration). Initially, Honors trained peer mentors will lead many of the cohort discussions and activities. However, as the term progresses, you and your peers will select and lead the discussions and activities.
